### **Street Cleaning**

Street cleaning occurs two days per week. Check the signs on your block to confirm the day and time. Usually, all cars must be moved by 8:00am and until 1:00pm.

The city parking enforcement team will ticket any cars remaining in no-park-zones, as indicated by street signage.

### **Trash Pick-up**

Trash pick-up is one day per week: Thursdays.

Bulk-trash pick-up can be scheduled by calling 311, or using the 311 app.

Hazardous materials drop-off occurs twice per year at designated locations.

Recycling pick-up is one day per week: Tuesdays. Baltimore City picks up single stream recycling with recycling out in yellow or blue bins. The city sorts and recycles off-site.
